Pronounced: ap°PEAL with the stress on the second syllable.

Primary definition:

noun: (1) a request for relief or justice (2) attractiveness or something of interest

Slide 3:

The sentence reads: After the 2011 tsunami in Japan, a group of Japanese students in the University of Brighton, UK, sent out this urgent appeal.

Slide 4:

The picture shows a sandy beach in the Caribbean.

The sentence reads: After enduring a long, hard winter, the idea of a holiday on a sundrenched beach in Puerto Rico had great appeal.

Slide 5:

The picture shows a neglected garden with an upturned wheelbarrow.

The sentence reads: Staying home all weekend to clean up an overgrown garden didn't have much appeal!

Remember, APPEAL means (1) a request for relief or justice, and (2) attractiveness or something of interest
